

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK HILL TENNESSEE, TO CALL AND PROVIDE FOR AN ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONERS OF OAK HILL, TENNESSEE: AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO GIVE NECESSARY ASSURANCES TO THE DAVIDSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION THAT THE COSTS OF SAID ELECTION WILL BE PAID BY THE CITY OF OAK HILL, TENNESSEE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK HILL as follows:

SECTION 1. That an election shall be called and held on the Eighth day of June, 2004, for the office of one Commissioner of the City of Oak Hill, Tennessee, for a term of four (4) years commencing on the first regular scheduled meeting of the Commissioners after the Eighth of June, 2004.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City of Oak Hill, Tennessee, that said election shall be called, held and conducted by the Davidson County Election Commission, pursuant to the General Election Laws of Tennessee.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all voters who are bona fide residents of Oak Hill, Tennessee, and also who are validly registered to vote in Oak Hill, Tennessee, under the general registration laws of Tennessee, shall be entitled to vote in said election.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Manager be and is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Davidson County Election Commission as official notice to the Davidson County Election Commission of the calling of the election herein specified.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized to give such assurances as may be necessary to the Davidson County Election Commission, that the City of Oak Hill, Tennessee will pay the necessary expenses of said election; and the City Manager is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to pay the necessary expenses of said election out of any funds appropriated for that purpose.
