

Ordinance 04-3

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A
MAXIMUM AMOUNT FOR PURCHASES
WITHOUT PUBLIC ADVERTISEMENT AND
COMPETITIVE BIDDING.**

WHEREAS, The City of Oak Hill is subject to the provisions of the "Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983"; and

WHEREAS, this said law has been amended permitting municipalities to increase the dollar amount of purchases requiring public advertisement and competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Oak Hill to increase said amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT

Section 1. Public advertisement and competitive bidding shall be required for the purchase of all goods and services exceeding an amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.⁰⁰) except for those purchases specifically exempted from advertisement and bidding by the Municipal Purchasing Act of 1983.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage and publication of its caption in a newspaper of general circulation.
