



Hall Income Tax

The largest revenue stream for the City of Oak Hill is the Hall Income Tax. This is a tax required by the State of Tennessee and paid (if required) on your annual State of Tennessee Income Tax Return.

The amount paid to the State is divided between the State and the local community. In order for the local community to receive their share, a resident must include Oak Hill in the City box on the return.

It is unusual for a citizen to live in a community and not have a mailing address that reflects that community's name. Since Oak Hill residents have a different mailing address, if Oak Hill is not specified on the state return then the City of Oak Hill will not receive the tax.

It is important to understand that you are legally obligated to pay the tax regardless of what community you live in. It does not cost any more if you live in Oak Hill. So if you file your Tennessee tax return without including "Oak Hill in the reference section on the form, then the income tax you pay will go to the community that is addressed on your form. For example, if Nashville is your mailing address and you don't include Oak Hill in the reference box, then the income tax you pay will go to Nashville.

The statement below is located on Page 1 of your State of Tennessee income tax return.

Because a portion of the tax goes back to the city or county of residence, please provide the county and city (if within an incorporated municipality) of the taxpayer's legal residence on the lines below.

The statement below is located on Page 3 of your State of Tennessee income tax return.

Distribution of Income Taxes Collected: Three-eighths (3/8) of the income taxes collected are distributed among the cities and counties of the state. In order for the taxes to be properly distributed, please provide the name of the county and city (if the taxpayer resides within an incorporated municipality) of the taxpayer's legal residence in the appropriate space on the front of the return.

GARBAGE/RECYCLING SERVICES

The City of Oak Hill awarded a three year garbage/recycling contract to Red River Waste Disposal LLC after a sealed bid process effective March 1, 2016.

This contract requires the City to pay approximately \$365,000 per year to provide garbage/recycling service to the residents of Oak Hill.

There are two major changes to the service that Red River will provide versus what was provided by the previous company Clean Earth. First, Red River will be providing service once a week on Fridays. Second, Red River will not be recycling glass. You either need to recycle glass on your own or put it in your regular trash. It is important to note that if Clean Earth had been awarded the garbage/recycling contract, they were no longer going to recycle glass.

There are two minor changes to the service that Red River will provide. First, your garbage needs to be placed in black or white bags. Second, all recycling items need to be placed in blue or clear bags. This process was created to ensure that recycling is handled properly and truly recycled.

Anytime Friday pickup is not possible, Red River will pick up on Saturday.
